Instant petition has been filed under Section 482, Cr.P.C. for directing official respondents to take action against private respondents No.7 to 9, who have forced petitioner's daughter to commit suicide and are accused in FIR No.261 dated 14.10.2021 registered under Section 306, IPC at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala, Annexure P-3. Another prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to initiate action against official respondents No.4 to 6 for failing to take timely action upon complaint dated 10.10.2021, Annexure P-1, given by petitioner's daughter, which ultimately led to her suicide on 13.10.2021.

Mr. Deepak Pareek, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala is present in person in compliance of order dated 27.05.2022 passed

by this Court. Status report by way of an affidavit of the said official has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and 5, which is taken on record.

Upon instructions from the official present in Court, State counsel submits that out of three accused, Tarlochan Singh and Jagmit Singh have been arrested, challan qua Tarlochan Singh has been presented on 09.06.2022 and challan against Jagmit Singh will be presented within a fortnight. In so far as the third accused, Charanjit Kaur is concerned, he submits that her arrest has been stayed by this Court in CRM-M-24709-2022, which is pending before this Court.

In view of explanation given in paras 7 to 11 of the affidavit, counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
