The petitioner has preferred this petition for the issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents for making publication of Part-2 Order in view of the entitlement of the petitioner.

The husband of the petitioner had served in Indian Army from 31.12.1974 to 31.08.1993. Earlier, the husband of the petitioner was married to Smt.Jasbir Kaur and no child was born out of the wedlock. Husband of the petitioner took divorce from his earlier wife on 18.10.2008 in the Court of competent jurisdiction and thereafter, remarried to the petitioner on 26.01.2020 according to Anand Karaj. The marriage was also registered with the Registrar of Marriages. The husband of the petitioner could not publish the marriage Part-2 Order and ultimately expired on 07.08.2020 due to Covid.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr.Gaurav Pathak, Advocate appears on behalf

of the respondent-Union of India and submits that Part-2 Order has been published on 14.11.2022 and now the petitioner is required to submit some documents in respect of the letter which has already been sent to her on 22.11.2022.

In view of the aforesaid factual position, this writ petition is disposed of. The petitioner shall respond to the requirements sought by the competent authority.
