AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition was filed seeking quashing of complaint No. 2602 of 2015, registered on 16th October, 2015, under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 pending in the Court of Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Karnal and summoning order dated 16th November, 2015 and order dated 13th September, 2016 declaring the petitioner proclaimed offender.

2. On 9th December, 2019 following order was passed:-

“At the outset, it is contended on behalf of the petitioner that instead of challenging the complaint as well as summoning order, he will confine his prayer only to join the proceedings before learned trial Court.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent for 19.03.2020.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before learned trial Court. On his doing so, he shall be released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing subject to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that petitioner

has been complied with the directions of this Court.

- 4. Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner, no interference is called for Section 482 Cr.P.C.
- 5. The petition is dismissed.
