This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and not to harass him unnecessarily for eliciting the information regarding brother of the petitioner, namely, Deepak, who is accused in FIR No.217 dated 04.10.2021, under Sections 457 and 380 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Jalalabad, District Fazilka and further to take appropriate action on the representation dated 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-1).

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the brother of the petitioner, namely, Deepak s/o Ram Parkash was arrested in case FIR No.217 dated 04.10.2021, under Sections 457 and 380 IPC, 1860, however, learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed for issuance of directions to the official respondents to decide his representation dated 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-1).

A perusal of the representation reveals that the petitioner had

approached the official respondents to seek directions against SHO, P.S.

City Jalalabad, District Fazilka, who was asking the petitioner to reveal the whereabouts of his brother Deepak, accused in case FIR No.217 dated 04.10.2021 (Annexure P-2). The representation was given after the pre arrest bail filed by the said accused was dismissed, but as the said accused has now been arrested, therefore, this Court does not find any merit in the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.
