In the present case, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner applied for appointment in pursuance of the advertisement (Annexure P-1) to the post of Librarian being fully eligible. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner had appeared in the written examination wherein, he has been awarded 82 marks and in the final result, the petitioner has not been selected though, as per the petitioner, the petitioner should have been given 86 marks in the written examination and 2.5 marks for the experience, which have not been given hence, the petitioner has not been given fair opportunity to compete.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition has already been raised in the representation dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-5), which is still pending consideration and he submits that the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents by

passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 1 is directed to decide the representation dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-5), by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
