Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to appoint petitioner as Peon, in view of order dated 25.04.2022 (P-17), passed by this Court.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits at this stage, her client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 02.08.2022 (P-20) is decided expeditiously.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3-Director, Public Instructions (Colleges), Punjab, to decide the aforesaid representation after taking into consideration the earlier order dated 25.04.2022 (P-17) in accordance with law within a period of 04 (four) weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
