1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 02.05.2022 in CWP-9193-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-9193-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide legal notice dated 27.03.2022, filed by the petitioner within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, has filed affidavit of the respondent along with copy of speaking order Annexure R/2 dated 07.10.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 27.03.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order, Annexure R/2 dated 07.10.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
