The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.3 & 4 to take appropriate action on the complaint dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) and to register a case against the accused persons in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that for his grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a complaint/representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur i.e. respondent No.3 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to take a decision on the representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
