1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.09.2021, in CWP-17499-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 07.09.2021, reveals that CWP-17499-2021, was disposed of in view of the stand of the respondents that the inquiry was at the final stage and consequential steps would be taken forthwith on receipt of the report.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that inquiry has been concluded, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge the action taken by the respondents pursuant to receipt of inquiry report, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
