This is a first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR no.210 dated 03.11.2020 registered under Sections 302 IPC (Sections 120-B, 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station Jodhewal, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.
