Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covil-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.0150 dated 17.11.2021 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station, City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

By virtue of the order dated 7.12.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 7.12.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
