After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court concerned within one week positively and would move an application there for seeking the relief of regular bail and she prays that the trial Court be directed to decide the bail application of the petitioner within some specific time frame and this petition may be disposed of accordingly.

Mr. Kunwarbir Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who has appeared in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance, has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands disposed of with a direction to the trial Court concerned that in case the petitioner surrenders

before it within the afore-stipulated period and moves any application for seeking the above-mentioned relief, the same be decided, in accordance with law, in the given set of the facts and circumstances of the case, within a period of three (03) days thereafter.
