VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.199 dated 13.09.2015, under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 18.02.2020, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioners. Again on 06.03.2020, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioners. Today also, none is present on behalf of petitioners to argue the matter.

From the abovesaid facts, it is apparent that the compromise has not fortified and therefore, no body has appeared on behalf of the

petitioners to pursue the present matter.

Keeping in view of the above, the present petition filed on the basis of compromise is dismissed. In case, the parties are willing to compromise the matter again and are ready to get the statements recorded, then it would be open to them to file a fresh petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.
