[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/5, dated 21.07.2022 in CWP No.15619 of 2022 in case titled as Sunita Devi vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/5 reveals that CWP No.15619 of 2022 was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation claiming the relief of family pension to the petitioner for the service rendered by her late husband, Sh. Manbir Singh.

[3] Learned AAG has filed affidavit of respondent No.2 along with copy of letter of deponent as well as speaking order, Annexures R/1 and R/2 dated 15.12.2022. The same are taken on record. Copies thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in view of speaking order, Annexure R/2 dated 15.12.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of

liberty to the petitioner to challenge order, Annexure R/2 dated 15.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
