Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.230 dated 05.09.2019, under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 14.12.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 14.12.2021, petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court.

In view of the above, interim order dated 14.12.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Petitioner is directed to continuously join the proceedings before the trial Court.
