This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of criminal complaint no.1862/19 dated 20.05.2019 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and summoning order dated 11.06.2019 and order dated 14.09.2022 whereby the revision petition has been dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take up all the points which have been raised in the present petition and are available with them, during the course of trial in accordance with law. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioner no.1 is 51 years of age and is a house wife and thus, prayed that the personal appearance of petitioner no.1 be exempted.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty

is exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Petitioner no.1 shall be represented through her counsel;
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii) shall not dispute her identity as accused;
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in her absence but in the presence of her counsel;
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;
- vi) any other condition which the trial Court may impose.
