1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 19.07.2021, in CWP-13027-2021, in case titled as Anju Bala vs. State of Punjab and others.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 19.07.2021, reveals that CWP-13027-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 01.03.2021, served by the petitioner in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within four months.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to issuance of notice, the respondent has rejected the claim made in legal notice dated 01.03.2021 vide order dated 15.02.2022 and the petitioner has challenged the same by way of CWP-6057-2022 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to pursue CWP-6057-2022,

in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
