1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 15.09.2022 in CWP-21050-2022.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to institution of the instant petition, benefit as per entitlement claimed in representation which was directed to be decided vide order Annexure P-1 has been allowed in favour of the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition.
