[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 25.05.2022, in CRWP No.4996 of 2022 in case titled as '**Lakhvir Singh** *versus* **State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful having been done in terms of order (Annexure P-1) and the representation of the petitioner having been decided by holding that there was no threat to the life of the petitioner but still one gunman has been provided for the security of the petitioner, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
