Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-7017 of 2021, titled as “Sheela Vs. State of Punjab and others”, dated 25.03.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order reads as under:-

“The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of pandemic of Covid-19.

Petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this court under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to convert/treat the case of petitioner under General Provident Fund (GPF) scheme, allot him GPF number and transferred the amount deducted from the pay and allowances on account of provident fund to GPF account along with interest and release the retiral benefits.

Upon hearing counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed off with directions to the respondents to read the legal notice dated 08.02.2021 (Annexure P-1) as representation of petitioner and decide the same fully in accordance with law by passing a speaking order

expeditiously, preferably within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

In reply, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioner has been rejected by the speaking orders dated 17.12.2021 and 08.03.2022.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to assail the correctness of the orders passed.
