The present petition has been moved by the petitioners seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her minor daughter at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner gave representations/complaint (Annexures P-1) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur but no action has been taken so far. He further submits that he will be satisfied if a time bound direction is given to the concerned police authorities to decide the aforesaid complaint/representation in a time bound manner.

Mr. B.S.Sewak, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submitted that in case any complaint/representation has been filed, the concerned authorities will consider and decide the same as per

law.

In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representations/complaint (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
