HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Through the present petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 91 dated 04.12.2020, registered under Sections 379, 411 IPC, at Police Station Sector-19, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was granted interim bail for a period of 90 days by the learned trial Court vide order dated 11.05.2021 and he has not misused the same and that on 04.10.2021, he could not appear before the Court because of ill health and accordingly, his surety/bail bonds were cancelled and forfeited to the State, and non-bailable warrants were issued against him.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submit that the case is now fixed before the learned trial Court for 29.10.2022 and the petitioner is ready to surrender before it and confines his prayer to the extent

of issuance of direction to the learned trial Court to decide the application for bail of the petitioner expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, learned Addl. PP UT Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the learned trial Court on 29.10.2022 and move an appropriate application for bail and on his doing so, the learned trial Court would decide the application for bail preferred by the petitioner expeditiously.
