[1] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite expiry of the period of time stipulated in order (Annexure P-2) dated 12.01.2017 in CWP No.228 of 2017, the representation of the petitioner has not been decided, till date.

[2] At the very outset, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 26.10.2022 passed by the Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Safidon, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in the representation filed by him. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of the claim of the petitioner having been rejected, she does not press the instant petition but prays for permission to challenge order dated 26.10.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
