The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent-authorities to promote the petitioner as Assistant from the date private respondent No.4 was promoted; who was junior to him and notional benefit be given to him.

A bare perusal of the record shows that the petitioner retired on 31.03.2020. Up to that date, no person junior to the petitioner had been promoted. The person, whom the petitioner is trying to portray as junior, was promoted on 06.11.2020, which is about seven months after the retirement of the petitioner. Therefore, there is nothing on record to show that any person junior to the petitioner was promoted while he was in service. The petitioner has not been able to point out any specific rule which required the respondents to make promotions or to prepare a panel for promotion within stipulated time every year.

Hence, this court does not find any merit in the petition as such.

Dismissed.
