No fresh ground as such is made out for granting the regular bail as has been prayed for because the period of custody alone cannot be a ground for accepting the prayer made in the present petition. A detailed order has been passed by this Court on 24.08.2021 in CRM-M-10050-2021, where reference was also made to an order dated 23.09.2020 passed in a petition filed by co-accused i.e. CRM-M-4719-2019, where the details along with the reasons for not accepting the bail had been given.

Keeping in view the huge recovery which has been effected in the present case and the role attributed to the petitioner, the prayer made in the present petition cannot be accepted and therefore, the same stands dismissed.
