Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.120 dated 2.9.2021 registered under Section 307, 341, 148, 149, 120-B IPC at Police Station City-1, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of order of interim bail dated 23.12.2021. This fact has been admitted by the counsel for the State who on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh submitted that the petitioner is not required by the police for any custodial interrogation. Counsel for the State further submitted that even the fact regarding compromise stated to have been effected between the parties, has been

verified by ASI Satpal Singh.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 23.12.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
