The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the due payment of Rs.46,74,156/- including the security qua the works executed by the petitioner.

The petitioner claims to be Government Contractor having been assigned the works of Provisional Water Supply Scheme, Mahpur, Block Khanna, District Ludhiana, Provisional Water Supply Scheme Bagli Khurd, Block Samrala, District Ludhiana, and Provisional Water Supply Scheme Diwala, Block Samrala, District Ludhiana, vide allotment letter dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the aforesaid works of Provisional Water Supply Scheme, Mahpur, Block Khanna,

District Ludhiana, Provisional Water Supply Scheme Bagli Khurd, Block Samrala, District Ludhiana, and Provisional Water Supply Scheme Diwala, Block Samrala, District Ludhiana, stand successfully executed, however, the payment against the execution of the aforesaid works has not been released, even though the final bills submitted by the petitioner already stand approved by the competent authority. He further contends that in this regard, a legal notice dated 20.08.2022 (Annexure P-3) has been sent by the petitioner and that despite a lapse of about 2 months since the date of legal notice neither any decision has been taken thereupon nor has the due and undisputed payment been released by the respondents. He contends that he would be satisfied in case the respondent authorities are directed to look into the legal notice and the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl.A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and the respondent No.4 - the Executive Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitation Division, Khanna, District Ludhiana, is directed to take note of the legal notice dated 20.08.2022 (Annexure P-3) sent by the petitioner and to pass a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner being established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
