Appellant-Mandip Kaur, has come up in this appeal against the order dated 13.10.2017, passed by the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Patiala, whereby the petition under Section 25 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, filed by the respondent for the custody of minor child-Akash Kaur, who was born after few months after the marriage of her son with Mandip Kaur, in the year 2001, was dismissed, with the visiting rights granted to respondent-Gurmit Kaur holding that the custody of minor child would be entrusted for 15 days in summer vacations and for 4 days in winter vacations.

In the present case, appellant was married with the son of respondent in the year 2001. Out of this wedlock one female child Akash Kaur, was born. After 5-6 months of the marriage, the husband of appellant was died in an accident.

Since the child-Akash Kaur, has attained majority, the present appeal has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having become infructuous.
