The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 CrPC praying for issuance of a writ for directing the official respondent No.1 and 2 to provide Police protection to the petitioners and their employees for execution/performance of handling and transport of trucks hired by them at their rice mills/place of business.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide his representation Annexure P-1 submitted by them. He relies on the orders passed by this Court dated 23.10.2012 and 19.03.2013 (Annexures P-3 and P-4).

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Manipal Singh Atwal, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no objection in deciding the representation filed on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners Annexure P-1 and decide the same expeditiously and if required take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
