Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0011 dated 15.10.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station NRI, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar (Punjab).

Vide order dated 10.12.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 10.12.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that recovery of the dowry articles is yet to be effected.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Kumar, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation

and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 10.12.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
