The present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to restrain the President to take any action for and on behalf of Haryana Ex-Services League (Society) in view of his removal from the post of President by the Collegiums.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that proceedings had earlier been instituted before the authorities under the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012 and the rules

framed thereunder and that a petition is now pending before the Registrar General which is listed for hearing on 23.11.2022 as well as one case is claimed to be pending before the State Registrar.

Learned counsel further contends that he would be satisfied in case the State Authorities are directed to decide pending petitions in a time bound manner considering that the total tenure of the office bearers is three years and already a period of 1½ years has elapsed.

The aforesaid prayer of the petitioner is not objected to by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.5 and 6.

In view of above and after noticing the consent of the concerned parties, the present writ petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent authorities to make an endeavour to finally adjudicate on the pending petitions before them subject to completion of the service and representation of the respective parties and preferably within a period of four months from the date already fixed before the respective authorities or by preponing the same on any application moved.

Pending misc. application, if any, shall also stand disposed off accordingly.
