Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR
No.122 dated 31.05.2020 registered under Section 452, 324, 326, 440, 148,
149 IPC, at Police Station City Fazilka.

The counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has
joined the investigation and cooperated with the police in compliance of the
order dated 23.12.2021 passed by this Court.

This fact has been admitted by the State counsel who made this
statement on the instructions of ASI Jaspal Singh and further stated that the
petitioner is not required by the police for any custodial interrogation as the
recovery has already been effected in this case.

The aforesaid FIR was registered against the petitioner and
other persons on the basis of the statement of one Surjit Singh. There is also
cross version (Annexure P-2), as per which the opposite party caused
injuries to the petitioner and his cousin Sumit.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and the fact that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required by the police for any other purpose, the petition is hereby allowed and the order of interim bail dated 23.12.2021 is made absolute subject to condition envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
