SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

On 17.12.2021, this Court passed the following order:-

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking setting aside of the impugned order dated 16.01.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram in FIR No.56 dated 19.11.2018 registered under Sections 323, 34, 406, 498-A, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Women West, District Gurugram, vide which the bail of the petitioner has been cancelled, bail bonds have been forfeited and non-bailable warrants have been issued.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR is an outcome of a marital dispute and the marriage of petitioner and complainant has been dissolved by virtue of judgment and decree dated 19.09.2019 (Annexure P- 8), in pursuance of a compromise arrived at between them. Counsel submits that the petitioner defaulted in appearance before the trial Court on 16.01.2020 under

bonafide impression that as the dispute had been settled, he was no longer required to appear. He submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and join the proceedings.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurmeet Singh, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court within a period of four weeks from today. In case, he does so and moves a petition seeking grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall release him on interim bail on reasonable conditions it deems appropriate by ensuring that such a default is not committed by the petitioner in future. This will be subject to deposit of the costs of Rs.20,000/- with the Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Sector 12, Chandigarh and the receipt of the deposit will be furnished by the petitioner on the date of his appearance before the trial Court.

The petitioner is directed to implead the complainant as party-respondent before the date fixed.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-8220 of 2021 on 06.04.2022.”

Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of the order dated 08.02.2022 passed by the trial Court and has submitted that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has furnished receipt of the deposit of Rs.20,000/- in the Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Sector 12, Chandigarh. He submits that the petitioner has been released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds along with surety.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has now appeared before the trial Court, interim order dated 17.12.2021 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition is disposed of.
