[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 29.10.2021 in CRM-M No.45462 of 2021 in case titled as Anju and another vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[3] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 29.10.2021 reveals that CRM-M No.45462 of 2021 was disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioners to submit representation within one week, with the representation to be decided in accordance with law within 15 days of receipt.

[4] Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the filing of the instant petition, the respondent has decided representation submitted by the petitioner vide order dated 07.12.2021, therefore, in the circumstances,

the petitioner to challenge order dated 07.12.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] In view of order dated 07.12.2021 having been passed by the respondent in compliance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 29.10.2021 in CRM-M No.45462 of 2021 as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any orders against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 07.12.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
