Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner had already cleared the written examination as well as in the scrutiny of the documents but nothing was pointed out but while declaring the final result, the petitioner has been declared ineligible and that too without disclosing the reasons for declaring the petitioner ineligible. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that after the declaration of the result, the petitioner has already approached the respondents by filing a representation dated 27.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) seeking the reasons as to why the petitioner has been declared ineligible and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises an objection in deciding the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 27.09.2022 (Annexure P-9), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the representation dated 27.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
