The petitioner has assailed the order dated 01.11.2021 passed by the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Patiala wherein the application filed by the petitioner for dismissal of petition under Section 128 Cr.P.C has been dismissed.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the period of Covid-19 Pandemic the amount of maintenance to the tune of Rs.30,000/- per month was paid to the respondent in cash against receipts, for a period of 3 months. However, no such objection was taken before the Executing Court in the application/objection petition and even the receipts were not placed on record at that point of time. He seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Executing Court afresh by filing an objection petition on fresh grounds.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, this order is not to be construed as an expression of genuineness of the claim of the petitioner, which he may raise in the objection

petition and the Executing Court will look into the matter independently keeping in view the entire circumstances appearing in the case an accordance with law.
