In the present writ petition, petitioner seeks grant of compensation on account of alleged malicious prosecution of the petitioner in FIR No.247 dated 04.08.2016 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, Police Station Zirakpur, District Mohali. For the relief in question, petitioner has to show that the FIR was lodged and the same was actuated with malice. In the order dated 26.02.2019, no findings have been recorded in respect of false or malicious involvement of the petitioner.

On 13.02.2020, the case was adjourned in order to enable the petitioner to satisfy the Court regarding maintainability of the present writ petition. Thereafter, on 19.02.2020, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner despite three pass overs and the case was adjourned to 26.03.2020.

On 23.03.2022 also, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Today also there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner despite two pass overs. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing this case any more.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
