Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) dated 23.09.2022, in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Barnala.

The petitioners have placed on record the copy of Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 & P-2) as proof of their age. They have also placed on record the Marriage Certificate as Annexure P-3.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Station House Officer, City Barnala, District Barnala that representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding marriage of the parties.
