This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.226 dated 7.11.2020, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, 1860 and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulations) Act, 2014, registered at PS Chheharta, Police Commissionerate, Amritsar, Punjab.

Vide order dated 15.2.2022, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail subject to his appearing before the Illaqa Magistrate for joining investigation.

On 8.3.2022, report of the learned Sessions Judge, Amritsar was called for on the fact as to whether the petitioner appeared before the Court or not.

Thereafter a miscellaneous application was filed stating that due to medical condition the petitioner could not appear before the Illaqa Magistrate.

The applicant was granted one more opportunity to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 25.3.2022.

Report dated 28.3.2022 was received that none appeared.

Learned State counsel also on instructions submits that the petitioner has not appeared before the Illaqa Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that *inspite of* his best efforts, he is not getting any instructions from the client and hence, is not in a position to pursue the petition.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for petitioner, the present petition is dismissed at this stage.
