This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.47 dated 14.04.2019 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Amargarh, Tehsil Malerkotla, District Sangrur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 27.09.2019 no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner and thereafter on 09.12.2019, a coordinate Bench of this Court had directed the parties to give statements before the trial Court / Duty Magistrate in support of the compromise. The learned trial Court has submitted its report in pursuance of the above said order that none of the parties had appeared before the trial Court. On 19.02.2020 notice was issued to respondent no.2 on depositing of fresh process fee. As per the Registry's report, process fee has not been filed so notice could not be issued. The case has been called twice. None of the parties have appeared.

From the above said facts, it is apparent that the compromise has not fructified and accordingly, the petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the parties to file a fresh petition for quashing of the above said FIR on the basis of compromise in case the compromise is still effectual and the parties are ready to get the statements recorded before the trial Court.
