[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 01.02.2022 in CRWP No.843 of 2022 in case titled as Rajnish Kumar vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CRWP No.843 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to look into the threat perception to the petitioner after affording opportunity to the respondent(s) also and to take appropriate steps in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of stand of the respondent in Annexure R/1 dated 13.05.2022 on the basis of enquiry that there was no threat to the petitioner by the private respondents, besides, directions had been issued to the SHO, Police Station BhainiMian Khan to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner,

he does not press the instant petition.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
