This second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been moved by the petitioner for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.115 dated 19.07.2021 under Sections 120-B, 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-17 Central, Chandigarh.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for U.T. Chandigarh, on instructions from quarter concerned submits that in compliance of order dated 14.01.2022, petitioner has already joined investigation and is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation. He further submits

that fees of Civil Engineer for site inspection to know the age as well as material used in the construction at the site in question, has already been deposited at the instance of petitioner and resultantly, site in question has already been inspected.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once petitioner has already made compliance of order dated 14.01.2022 in letter and spirit, interim order may be made absolute and instant petition be disposed of accordingly.

In view of above, order dated 14.01.2022 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
