This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.126 dated 04.09.2022 registered under Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh, has pointed out that the petitioner is involved in four more cases which fact has not been mentioned in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after mentioning the details of the other cases in which the petitioner has been implicated and also after mentioning as to whether he is on bail in the said cases or not.
