Present writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of quo-warranto directing respondent No.6 to disclose the authority under which he is holding office of Traffic Manager.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioners, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 06.09.2022 (P-7) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim of petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice as per law, within two weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needles to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioners would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
