AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)Case heard *via* video conference.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.128, dated 29.08.2021, having been registered at Police Station Verka, District Amritsar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 379-B(2)/411/34 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even if the contents of the FIR are to be accepted at face value (though denied), the petitioner is alleged to have snatched brass earrings from the complainant and though he was apprehended at the spot, there is no other FIR registered against him, with him being about 25 years old and with him having been in custody for about 6 ½ months, with the trial still to commence.

As regards the factual position learned State counsel does not deny the same though of course he opposes the petitioner being admitted to bail.

Having considered the matter without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon him furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
