The instant petition has been filed invoking writ jurisdiction of this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the action the respondents for withdrawal of the petitioner security detail order dated 11.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) without any basis by publishing the same on Television, Newspapers and Social Media to claim credit and endangering the petitioner's life.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the

petitioner is a politician belonging to the Congress Party and petitioner started her political career in 2004. He contends that petitioner had been elected from the Sri Muktsar Sahib Constituency on an Indian National Congress, ticket in the year 2012. He contends that the petitioner had also written a letter to respondent No.4-ADGP Security urging him to restore her security detail. He contends that the petitioner received a death threat via Whatsapp Call from phone number +1(651)666-4177 on 26.06.2022. He further places reliance on the judgment passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in the matter of **Om Parkash Soni Vs. State of Punjab and others**, bearing CWP No.11872 of 2022, decided on 22.08.2022. It is further submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents to look into the representations which have been appended along with the present petition as Annexures P-2 and P-3 sent to respondent No.4-ADGP, Security and take a decision on the same after taking into consideration all the relevant aspects.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the prayer of the petitioner is accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and with a direction to the respondent authorities to decide the representations annexed as Annexure P-2 and P-3 sent by the

petitioner and to pass an appropriate order thereupon, within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, as per security policy adopted by the State of Punjab, after affording opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.

The present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
