Prayer in this petition is for transfer of the petition filed under Section 25 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which is pending before the Additional District Judge, Sangrur i.e. in case HMA/475/2019, to the competent Court of jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the respondent/husband had filed the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which was decreed ex parte on 01.11.2008. Thereafter, the petitioner filed FAO (M) No.147 of 2009, before this Court and the same was dismissed as withdrawn on 15.07.2014, as the respondent had already remarried on 02.09.2009 and this Court has further directed to the respondent to pay Rs.5,000/- per month maintenance to the petitioner vide order dated 15.07.2014. The order was directed to remain in force till the lifetime of the petitioner. It was further directed that the petitioner will be at liberty to seek enhancement of the maintenance by moving an appropriate application

under Section 25 of the Hindu Marriage Act before the trial Court and now, the petitioner has filed an application under Section 25 of the Hindu Marriage Act on the ground that her minor daughter is studying in school and to bear her day-to-day expenses, she is entitled for enhancement of amount of maintenance. Lastly, it is argued that the said petition is pending before the Court at Family Court, Sangrur and the petitioner, who is not having sufficient source of income is unable to pursue the petition at Sangrur, which is at the distance of about 80 Km from her place of residence at Ludhiana.

There is no representation on behalf of the respondent.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petition filed under Section 25 of the Hindu Marriage Act, pending in the Court of Additional District Judge, Sangrur, is ordered to be transferred to the court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.
