The instant petition has been filed under 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No. 129 dated 09.07.2019 registered under Sections 323, 506, 341 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326/324 of the IPC were added later on) (Annexure P-1) at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 08.11.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded towards verification of the compromise and a report in this regard was to be submitted by the illaqa Magistrate. A report bearing memo No. 121 dated 12.02.2020 has been received as per which the parties did not turn up in the Court for getting their statements recorded due to which no opinion could be expressed on the genuineness of the alleged

compromise.

Today also there is no representation on behalf of the respondents No.2 and 3 to reiterates the existence of the settlement or not. In the said circumstances, this Court has no option to assume that the settlement has not yet been finalized between the parties. The present petition is accordingly dismissed at this stage with liberty to the parties to approach afresh as and when the settlement mature amongst the parties.

Dismissed at this stage with liberty aforesaid.
