The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing respondents to refix the pension and the retirement benefits of the petitioner and to release the arrears and future pension by considering grade pay as Rs.3600 of the petitioner who got superannuated on 31.03.2020 within a stipulated period time alongwith interest @ 18% per annum for delay and harassment, for which, representation dated 02.09.2021 (Annexure P/5) has also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider representation dated 02.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay.
