The petitioner herein seeks the issuance of direction to the respondent-State for constituting a Board and to get his mother's medical examination conducted by the said Board.

After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be moving a representation to the Director General of Police, Punjab, to seek the redressal of his grievance, as canvassed in this petition, within three days and he prays that the above-said authority be directed to look into and decide the said representation within some specific time frame.

Mr. Karanbir Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 in this case in pursuance of the copies of the instant petition having been

sent to the respondent-State in advance, has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Punjab through respondent No.1 that in case the petitioner moves any representation before him, qua his afore-mentioned prayer, within three days from today, he shall look into the same and take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in the given set of the facts and circumstances of the matter, preferably within a period of two weeks.
